## Building Operator Certification Scholarship

This scholarship was created in partnership with the Building Operator Certification program and Washington Association of Maintenance and Operations Administrators - WAMOA.

**WAMOA** - An organization of educational facilities and maintenance professionals in Washington State. Our mission is to promote diversity and foster the highest degree of professionalism in its members, and to enhance their professional competence through education.

### Scholarship Details:

- One (1) **Building Operator Certification (BOC) Scholarship** will be offered annually to a prospective BOC student.
- The scholarship covers:
  - Training and Certificate Completion (Value over \$2000)
  - Certification Examination (Value over \$280)

### Eligibility:

- Minimum of two years experience in maintenance and operations of a commercial or institutional facility,
- OR minimum one year of the above experience plus minimum of one year of technical college level education in a facilities engineering related program,
- OR a minimum of two years in energy management of facilities with a focus on maintenance and operations.
- Members of the Programs Committee are not eligible.

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### Application Process:

- BOC Applications are due January 15th by end-of-day.
- Once received, applications will be forwarded to the Programs Committee for immediate review by WAMOA and the BOC program.
