

WAMOA Sponsorship Program

Program Information and Sponsorship Application

The Sponsorship Program was created as a means of assisting WAMOA members, and potential members, in achieving greater professional expertise through attendance at WAMOA sanctioned events or training when funding is not available through their school district or other means.

The Programs Committee is responsible for review of applications, distribution, and award of budgeted sponsorship funds in accordance with program guidelines and in a manner their collective judgment deems most supportive of the applicant, the organization and its stated mission. The committee may elect to award as many or as few sponsorships as they determine to be appropriate based on review of current applications and/or funding availability.

There are two types of eligibility. The first is to be an active WAMOA member in good standing. The second is to be a non-member with an interest in the organization and possessing the potential to obtain membership. Applications may be submitted by WAMOA members and non-members or by a school district superintendent (or designee) on behalf of a current WAMOA member.

Previous recipients who are WAMOA members are eligible to apply. First time applicants receive priority consideration. Non-members who have previously received sponsorship funding are not eligible to submit additional application(s) for funding support. Members of the programs committee are not eligible.

Applicants will be evaluated by the following criteria: The number of applications received, past funding received, available monies, timeliness, and membership status. Active participation in WAMOA will also be a consideration. Regional and Annual meeting attendance and involvement may be considered. Additional consideration will be given to applicants from districts who have experienced multiple levy failures or budget shortfalls.

Individuals wishing to apply for a sponsorship should submit the application form and any supporting documentation to the Program Chair by February 1st for Leadership and by August 15th for the Annual Conference. Applicants will be notified immediately upon review of their application materials and the committee's decision.
